



MacArthur Park Camp Cornerstone Travel Information

Dear Cornerstone Campers and Parents,

We are so excited that you are going to camp with us. We are looking forward to a great week at Camp Cornerstone. Here is some important information you need to know about our trip. Cornerstone is for our students who have just completed the 5th grade - 8th grade in the 2020-2021 school year.

Departure

Please be at the church building no later than 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, June 27th. We will be administering COVID-19 Rapid Tests, so it is important that you arrive on time. We will depart at 6:30 a.m. Set a few alarm clocks that morning. Plan to be here earlier rather than later that morning. We will take our church vans or a charter bus depending on size of the group. Be sure to check in at our check-in table immediately upon arrival at Mac that morning. You will be given directions on where to put luggage, what to do with medication and other information.

Please check in with a \$20 cash key deposit in a marked envelope and 2 separate marked envelopes with \$10 cash each in them that will be used for a lunch stop at a fast food restaurant that day and for dinner on the trip home. Teens are to eat breakfast before departure or bring a breakfast snack on board.

Our adult sponsor will be leading the trip. The interns and I will be there to welcome everyone upon their arrival at camp.

Travel

Since we will be administering tests before departure, we will not be requiring masks to be worn in the van. However, it will be important to have a mask with you for any stops we make. We will not be filling each van to max capacity, but will put close to 8 students per van.

Return

All Camp Cornerstone campers will return Thursday, July 1st, between 9:00 and 10:30 p.m. We will call when we get close so that you don't need to wait in the parking lot for an extended period of time.

What To Bring

Bible, a few masks (3-4), pillow, sleeping bag (or bedding for twin mattress), toiletries, personal items, towels, modest swimsuit, tennis shoes (must have for service project), pens, modest clothing and key deposit (\$20 cash that will be refunded when your key is returned at the end of

the week). There will also be an optional concession stand in the afternoons and evenings for snacks and cokes. Youth may bring this separate money with them to camp.

Updated Medical Release Forms

Please download and complete a 2021 Medical Release Form. You must have this to me before the bus departs. You can download this form at www.macyouth.org.

Medication

All medication must be checked in at Mac that Sunday morning before departure and should be in their original containers. There will be a “Camper Medication Information Form” that must be completed. Please fill the top half of this form out, one per teen, and hand it to us at check-in that morning along with the medication. Please put all of these items in a marked zip-lock bag.

Food Allergies

Parents, do your teens have any food allergies that CampOC needs to know about?

Please contact me right away about this if you have not done so already.

Travel and Electronic Equipment

You may bring iPods, cell phones, etc. for the trip, but these MAY NOT be taken into the dorms during Camp Cornerstone. I will collect them for safe keeping during the week. This is camp policy. As we seek to honor God and grow closer to Him at camp (the reason we are going), let us honor God by respecting the rules set forth by the leaders of this camp. All technology will be returned to you for the return trip home.
