



MacArthur Park Camp Zentih Travel Information

Hey Z-Campers and Parents,

We are so excited that you are going to camp with us. We are looking forward to a great week at Camp Zenith. Here is some important information you need to know about our trip. Zenith is for our students who have just completed the 9th - 12th grades in the 2020-2021 school year.

Prepare

Spend time in the Word and in prayer, asking God to open your heart to what He wants to change in you during your week at camp.

Check-In & Departure

Please be at the church building no later than 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, June 20th. We will be administering COVID-19 Rapid Tests, so it is important that you arrive on time. We will depart at 6:30 a.m. Set a few alarm clocks that morning. Plan to be here earlier rather than later that morning. We will take our church vans or a charter bus depending on size of the group. Be sure to check in at our check-in table immediately upon arrival at Mac that morning.

Travel

Since we will be administering tests before departure, we will not be requiring masks to be worn in the van. However, it will be important to have a mask with you for any stops we make. We will not be filling each van to max capacity, but will put close to 8 students per van.

Return

Our church vans are scheduled to arrive back in San Antonio between 9:00 and 10:30 p.m. on that Thursday, June 24th. Teens will be able to contact you on their phones along the way. Adult sponsors will be leading the caravan home. Teens will have eaten dinner before arrival back at Mac. Students who are working at Camp Cornerstone will remain in Oklahoma with me and our summer interns to prepare for our next week of CampOC.

What To Bring

Bible, a few masks (3-4), pillow, sleeping bag (or bedding for twin mattress), personal items, towels, modest swimsuit, tennis shoes (must have for service project), toiletries, pens, modest clothing and key deposit (\$20 cash that will be refunded when your key is returned at the end of the week).

Updated Medical Release Forms

Please download and complete a 2021 Medical Release Form. You must have this to me before the bus departs. You can download this form at www.macyouth.org.

Medication

All medications should be in their original containers and must be checked in at Mac that Sunday morning before departure. There will be a “Camper Medication Information Form” that must be completed. Please fill the top half of this form out, one per teen, and hand it to us at check-in that morning along with the medication. Please put all of these items in a marked zip-lock bag.

Meals, Snacks and Extra Money Needed

You will need money for two fast food meals, one on the trip up and one on the way back (about \$20 - \$30 total). You may bring your own breakfast snack for departure. We are not stopping for breakfast. Remember, a \$20 cash refundable key deposit is also required. There is a concession stand (optional) open in the afternoons and evenings for snacks and cokes. This is also where you can place late night pizza orders. Again, this is optional.

Food Allergies

Parents, do your teens have any food allergies that CampOC needs to know about?
Please contact me about this right away.

Staying Over for Camp Cornerstone

If you are staying over to be a camper or a leader at Camp Cornerstone, please bring an additional amount of at least \$45 for your meals that weekend. All other spending money is optional. I will have laundry detergent for you to use. You do not need any money for laundry. You also do not need to bring “church clothes”. We will have Sunday morning services as a camp staff on campus. The Camp Cornerstone group is set to return Thursday night, July 1st, between 9:00 and 10:30 p.m. Teens will be able to contact you on their phones along the way. Teens will have eaten dinner before arriving back at Mac.

Travel and Electronic Equipment

You may bring iPods, cell phones, etc. for the trip, but electronics MAY NOT be taken into the dorms during Zenith. I will collect them for safe keeping during the week. This is camp policy. As we seek to honor God and grow closer to Him at camp (the reason we are going), let us honor God by respecting the rules set forth by the leaders of this camp. You will have your devices given back to you for the return trip home.
